ELIGIBILITY

This International Exhibition is open to all artists 18 year of age and older working in the acrylic medium on any surface. This is an open opportunity for all Acrylic Artists who work in all sizes but especially in very large formats where shipping to shows is financially prohibitive. This show will be permanently archived on the ISAP website, www.isap-online.com
You do not have to be a member of ISAP to submit images and be accepted.

DIGITAL ENTRY

(February 28, 2015 deadline)

Your digital image should be RGB color in JPEG format with a maximum file size of 3MB. Images should be at 72 (dpi/ppi standard web resolution) and 1920 pixels on longest side.

ENTRY FEES

(Nonrefundable)

ISAP Members whose dues have been paid for the current year may submit one image for an entry fee of \$30 or two images for an entry fee of \$35.

Non-members may submit one image for an entry fee of \$40 or two images for an entry fee of \$45. A membership form can be found on our website www.isap-online.com

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All artists must be 18 years of age or older.
2. All entries must be original works of art created by the artist and executed with 80% of the surface done in the acrylic medium on any surface.
3. Due to copyright issues all identifiable collage pictures must contain only original photographic images taken by the artist.
4. All work must have been created in the past three years and not accepted or exhibited in any other ISAP show.
5. Work accepted in a previous ISAP Show or Exhibition disqualifies entry of that piece into a current ISAP Show or Exhibition.

6. Work does not have to be for sale and may even be already sold!
7. There is NO minimum or maximum size.
8. Selected works will be exhibited on the ISAP website. Failure to exhibit accepted work disallows entry to another ISAP Show or Exhibition for two years.
9. It is understood that the work is subject to the conditions of the show and reproduction will be archived on the ISAP website.
10. ISAP members in good standing who have their work accepted into the show will receive one point towards achieving Signature Membership status. An ISAP membership form can be found on our website www.isap-online.com.

The overall scope of the **International Society of Acrylic Painters** is very diverse representation of a wide range of subject matter and styles. ISAP members and entrants have a significant reputation in the art collecting community with galleries and buyers actively checking the ISAP website.

Linda Kemp

Canadian artist/author Linda Kemp is internationally recognized for her unique contemporary watercolors and acrylics which incorporate her innovative use of negative painting. She is the author of two books, *Watercolor Painting Outside the Lines- A Positive Approach to Negative Painting* and *Simplifying Design and Color For Artists - Positive Results Using Negative Painting Techniques* (North Light Books) and presenter in numerous instructional art videos and internet forums. She is also a contributing writer and demonstrator in six additional books. Her paintings and articles have been featured in publications such as *American Artist*, *Watercolor Magic*, *International Artist*, *Watercolor Artist*, *Watermedia Focus* and *Palette Magazine*.

Kemp is an elected member of the Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour (awarded Life Membership 2013), the Ontario Society of Artists and the Society of Canadian Artists. This artist is profiled in Canadian Who's Who and Who's Who Canadian Women, the Dictionary of International Biography and the 20th Anniversary Edition of Trivial Pursuit. Her award winning paintings are in private, government and corporate collections around the world, including The Royal Collection, Windsor Castle, U.K. and the private collection of HRH the Prince of Wales.

A full time artist, she frequently instructs and lectures at national symposiums and workshops throughout Canada, the United States, the United Kingdom and France. She was the recipient of the 2005 Woman of Distinction Award for Arts and Culture and in 2008 received the A.J. Casson Medal for Outstanding Achievement in Water Colour, the top award for The Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour National Juried Exhibition.
